Day 06 Jaisalmer Explore

Today we explore Jaisalmer City. We visit Golden Fort – a UNESCO world heritage site and one of the very few living forts in the world, as nearly one fourth the population of the city still resides within the Fort followed by visit to Jain Mandir – craved in yellow sandstones dedicated to Jain hermits known as Tirthankars. Later we visit Patwon ki Haweli Museum – Palace built in early 1800s, now a museum featuring intricate carvings, furniture and artwork and see Nathmalji ki haveli. It’s time to visit Kuldhara – an abandoned village believed to be cursed. We then proceed to famous Sam Sand Dunes. Upon arrival we experience thrilling Dune Bashing over the golden sands of Jaisalmer.

Sightseeing for the day

- Jaisalmer Fort, Massive, 12th-century fortified city featuring ornate Jain temples with idols & stone carvings.
- Kothari's Patwon Ki Haveli, Series of early-1800s palaces, now a museum featuring intricate carvings, furniture & artwork.
- BADA BAGH, Series of ornate stone cenotaphs dedicated to the royal family, dating to the 16th century.
- Gadisar Lake, Created in the 14th century, this lake is now known for its temples, shrines & migratory birds.
- Jaisalmer War Museum, Patriotic museum showcasing information & history about the Indian Army & the wars it has fought.
- Salam Singh Ki Haweli (Moti Mahal), Architecturally notable residence built in 1815 with a peacock-shaped roof & numerous balconies.
- Nathmal Ki Haveli, Privately owned 19th-century haveli known for ornate exterior carvings & unique architecture.
- Vyas Chhatri, Rajasthani-style sandstone cenotaph of the sage Vyas, who wrote the Mahabharata epic.
- Kuldhara, ?Kuldhara is ??an abandoned village in the Jaisalmer district of Rajasthan??. India. Established around the 13th century, it was once a prosperous village inhabited ..

Day 07 Jaisalmer - Jodhpur

We Visit The Mehrangarh Fort – Which Stands Four Hundred Feet Above The Skyline Of Jodhpur. The Fort Is Burnished In Red Sandstone And Its Colossal Structure Is Surely Impressive In All Manner. Here We Will See Moti Mahal – Largest Room In Fort Whose Ceiling Is Decorated With Gold Leaves, Sea Shells And Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure Dome Of The Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative Mirror Palace With Brightly Coloured Paintings, Silah Khana – Place Where Weapons Were Stored, Daulat Khana – Treasure Vault And Rang Mahal. Later We Visit Jaswant Thada – A Royal Cenotaph Built In The White Marble Also Known As Taj Mahal Of Marwar. We Then See The Sanganeri Block Prints Demonstration – A Hand-block Printing Technique Originating From Sanganer. Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Jaswant Thadda, Toor Ji Ka Jhalra, Kaylana Lake.

Sightseeing For The Day

- Mehrangarh is a historical fort located in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India.
- Jaswant Thada is a white marble monument located near the Mehrangarh Fort in Jodhpur.
- Mandore Garden, People say this garden offers beautiful architecture, cenotaphs, and temples, and is a peaceful place to spend time with family. They also highlight the affordable entry fee, the fun toy train ride, and the informative light and sound show.
- Ghantaghar (Clockhouse), This tourist attraction is a beautiful clock tower with a working clock mechanism and a view of the Mehrangarh Fort. Apart from this, the vibrant local market around the clock tower is also worth visiting.
