Day 03 Srinagar to Gulmarg and back to Srinagar

Located at an altitude of 2,650 meters, about 50 kilometers from Srinagar, Gulmarg is surrounded by snow-capped mountains, lush meadows, and pine forests. In summer, the valley comes alive with colorful wildflowers like daisies and blue poppies, while in winter, it transforms into a white paradise, earning it a reputation as India's premier skiing destination. The world-famous Gulmarg Gondola, one of the world's highest cable cars, takes tourists to Afrawat Peak, offering breathtaking panoramic views of the Himalayas. Major attractions include Khilanmarg, Alpathar Lake, St. Mary's Church, Maharani Temple, and the Gulmarg Golf Courseâ€"one of the world's highest golf courses. Adventure seekers can enjoy skiing, snowboarding, trekking, and sledding, while nature lovers can soak in the serene mountain beauty. Whether covered in blooming flowers or shimmering in snow, Gulmarg is a year-round wonder that offers a perfect blend of adventure, tranquility, and the unmatched charm of Kashmir.

Day 04 Srinagar To Sonmarg And Back To Srinagar



Located approximately 80 kilometers from Srinagar, Sonamarg, meaning "meadow of gold," is a charming hill station in the Ganderbal district of Jammu and Kashmir. Situated at an altitude of approximately 2,730 meters, Sonamarg is surrounded by snow-capped Himalayan peaks, lush meadows, and glistening glaciers, making it one of the most picturesque destinations in the Kashmir Valley. During spring and summer, the valley is ablaze with golden alpine flowers and lush pastures, while in winter, Sonamarg transforms into a magical snowy paradiseâ€"ideal for skiing, snow trekking, and sledding. The Sindh River flows through the valley, further enhancing its charm and offering opportunities for trout fishing and white-water rafting. Sonamarg is also the gateway to the famous Zoji La Pass and the base point for several popular treks, such as the Amarnath Yatra and the Vishansar, Krishansar, and Gangbal lakes. Major attractions include the stunning Thajiwas Glacier, the Nilagrad River, the Baltal Valley, and the Zoji La Pass, offering incredible natural beauty and adventure. Whether you're looking for adventure, tranquility, or simply the beauty of untouched nature, Sonamarg embodies the essence of Kashmir's alpine charmâ€"truly living up to its name, "Golden Field."

Day 05 Srinagar to Pahalgam



Located approximately 90 kilometers from Srinagar, Pahalgam, often referred to as the "Valley of Shepherds," is one of the most picturesque destinations in Jammu and Kashmir. Located at an altitude of approximately 2,200 meters in the Lidder Valley, the town is surrounded by dense pine forests, snow-capped mountains, and the crystal-clear Lidder River flowing through the valley. Pahalgam is a popular destination for trekking, camping, fishing, and horseback riding, and is also the starting point for the famous Amarnath Yatra. The surrounding meadows and valleys, including Aru Valley, Betaab Valley, and Chandanwari, offer breathtaking views and are perfect for photography, nature walks, and picnics. During summer, the valley blooms with vibrant wildflowers, while in winter, Pahalgam transforms into a snowy wonderland, attracting both adventure enthusiasts and nature lovers. The serene atmosphere, fresh mountain air and natural beauty make Pahalgam an ideal place for relaxation,

adventure and reconnecting with nature.

Day 06 Pahalgam to Katra



After breakfast we left for Katra.

"Katra Market" may refer to the shopping areas located in Katra, Jammu, near the Vaishno Devi Temple, which is famous for Kashmiri handicrafts and religious items, or it may also refer to the Katra Jaimal Singh Market in Amritsar, Punjab, a historic commercial center. The markets of Jammu Katra sell goods such as pashmina shawls, religious artifacts, and souvenirs (As per your choice).

Day 07 Katra to Bhawan (Mata Vaishno Devi Pilgrimage Route)



Katra is a small town located at the foothills of the Trikuta Mountains in the Jammu region of Jammu and Kashmir. Located approximately 50 kilometers from Jammu city, it is the gateway to the sacred Vaishno Devi Temple, one of India's most revered pilgrimage sites. Nestled among picturesque hills and valleys, Katra is a blend of spiritual significance and natural beauty. The town offers a serene atmosphere, clean roads, and suitable accommodation for both pilgrims and tourists. The Mata Vaishno Devi pilgrimage route begins here, attracting millions of devotees each year, who travel through winding paths lined with temples, resting places, and scenic views of the Trikuta Mountains. Beyond its religious significance, Katra provides a tranquil base for exploring the surrounding hills, forests, and rivers, making it a perfect blend of spirituality and nature. The town comes alive during festivals and pilgrimage season, creating a vibrant and serene atmosphere for visitors.

Mata Vaishno Devi Pilgrimage Route (Katra to Shrine)

- Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine is one of India's most revered Hindu pilgrimage sites, located in the Trikuta Mountains of Jammu & Kashmir, about 12 km from Katra. The pilgrimage combines spiritual devotion with breathtaking mountain scenery.
- The pilgrimage begins in the town of Katra, where accommodation, shops, and guides are available.
- This town serves as the base for trekking or helicopter rides to the temple.
- Approximately 12 km uphill from Katra to the temple.
- Bhairon Temple: Near the end of the trek; devotees often stop here to pray before reaching the main temple.
- Path Features: The route is well-paved in most areas, with numerous rest stops, shops, medical aid centers, and refreshment stalls.
- On foot: Popular among devotees seeking a spiritual experience.
- Pony/Horseback Rides: Available for those who need assistance or prefer an easier journey.
- Helicopter Service: A short 5-10-minute flight from the Katra helipad to Bhawan (near the temple).
- Holy Cave/Temple: The final destination, located inside a cave in the Trikuta Hills, is where the idol of Mata Vaishno Devi is enshrined.

- Darshan: Devotees pay homage to the sanctum sanctorum; the cave maintains a peaceful, spiritual atmosphere.
- Accommodation and food are available in Katra, along the trek route, and near the temple.
- Medical facilities, drinking water stations, and rest stops ensure a safe journey.
- The route is well marked with signs and safety measures.

Day 08 Katra to Amritsar (Wagah Border)



Wagah Border is a famous border crossing between India and Pakistan, located approximately 30 kilometers from Amritsar, Punjab. It is famous for its daily flag-lowering ceremony, a dramatic and patriotic display that attracts thousands of tourists every day. Held every evening before sunset, this ceremony is performed jointly by the Indian Border Security Force (BSF) and the Pakistan Rangers. Highly coordinated drills and marching by soldiers. Soldiers proclaim national spirit with patriotic songs, slogans, and dances. The flags are lowered at the same time, after which the border gates are closed. This ceremony lasts approximately 30-45 minutes and is a major attraction for both domestic and international tourists. Seating galleries for visitors are located on both sides of the border. Vendors selling snacks, souvenirs, and refreshments are located near the entrance. Ample parking and easy access from Amritsar city.

Day 09 Amritsar Explore and Amritsar Departure



Amritsar, located in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, is one of the most spiritually and culturally rich cities in India. Founded by Guru Ram Das Ji, the fourth Sikh Guru, in 1577, Amritsar is best known as the spiritual and cultural center of Sikhism. At the heart of the city lies the magnificent Golden Temple (Sri Harmandir Sahib) â€" the holiest shrine of Sikhism. The temple's gold-plated structure and its reflection in the Amrit Sarovar (holy tank) create a breathtaking sight, especially during sunrise and sunset. Pilgrims from around the world visit to seek peace and spiritual solace here. Apart from its religious significance, Amritsar also holds immense historical importance. The Jallianwala Bagh, located near the Golden Temple, stands as a memorial to the tragic massacre of 1919, reminding visitors of India's struggle for freedom.
