Amritsar, Located In The Northwestern Indian State Of Punjab, Is One Of The Most Spiritually And Culturally Rich Cities In India. Founded By Guru Ram Das Ji, The Fourth Sikh Guru, In 1577, Amritsar Is Best Known As The Spiritual And Cultural Center Of Sikhism. At The Heart Of The City Lies The Magnificent Golden Temple (Sri Harmandir Sahib) — The Holiest Shrine Of Sikhism. The Temple's Gold-plated Structure And Its Reflection In The Amrit Sarovar (holy Tank) Create A Breathtaking Sight, Especially During Sunrise And Sunset. Pilgrims From Around The World Visit To Seek Peace And Spiritual Solace Here. Apart From Its Religious Significance, Amritsar Also Holds Immense Historical Importance. The Jallianwala Bagh, Located Near The Golden Temple, Stands As A Memorial To The Tragic Massacre Of 1919, Reminding Visitors Of India's Struggle For Freedom.

Places to visit in amritsar today

- Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib): The holiest shrine of Sikhism. Famous for its stunning golden architecture and peaceful atmosphere. Don't forget to enjoy the langar (community meal) – one of the largest free kitchens in the world.
- Jallianwala Bagh: The historical memorial of the 1919 massacre. Visit to pay homage and see the preserved bullet marks and the Martyrs' Well.
- Durgiana Mandir: A Hindu temple similar in architecture to the Golden Temple. Dedicated to Goddess Durga, it also houses shrines to Lakshmi and Vishnu.
- Partition Museum: Located near the Town Hall. Displays stories, photographs, and artifacts from the 1947 Partition of India – highly emotional and educational.

- Hall Bazaar: One of Amritsar's oldest markets. Great for shopping for Punjabi juttis, phulkari dupattas, handicrafts, and souvenirs.
- Gobindgarh Fort: An 18th-century fort now converted into a cultural and historical museum. Enjoy light and sound shows, live performances, and Punjabi food.
- Mata Lal Devi Temple: A colorful temple dedicated to a female saint. Known as "Mini Vaishno Devi," it has narrow cave-like tunnels and mirrored walls.
- Ram Tirth Ashram: This ancient site is believed to be the birthplace of Luv and Kush (sons of Lord Ram). It boasts a large pond, temples, and a serene, spiritual atmosphere.
- Akal Takht: One of the five Takhts (seats of authority) of Sikhism. Located within the Golden Temple complex.
- Wagah Border (Attari Border): Famous for the Beating Retreat ceremony between Indian and Pakistani soldiers.
- Patriotic atmosphere with cheering crowds and flag hoisting every evening.
