Day 02 Gangtok to Darjeeling

After breakfast check out from the hotel and leave for Darjeeling. After reaching Darjeeling we checked in at the hotel, freshened up and toured the city.

Darjeeling, known as the "Queen of the Hills," is a picturesque hill station in West Bengal, India, famous for its spectacular views of the Himalayas, especially Kanchenjunga, its tea plantations, and the historic Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here is more detailed information about Darjeeling: Location and Geography: Himalayan Foothills: Darjeeling is located in the foothills of the eastern Himalayas in the northernmost region of West Bengal. Mountain Ridge: It is situated on a long, narrow mountain range that descends abruptly to the bed of the great Rangit River. Darjeeling is rich in cultural and natural heritage, with a wide variety of attractions and activities. Darjeeling is home to a variety of wildlife, including the Himalayan flying squirrel, Assam macaque, and Indian leopard. Other popular attractions include the Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park, the Batasia Loop, and the Japanese Peace Pagoda. Darjeeling was once a sanitarium for British soldiers and administrators and was known as the "Queen of the Hills." The British East India Company turned the Darjeeling area into a hill station in the 1800s. The name "Darjeeling" is derived from the Tibetan words "dorje" (vajra) and "ling" (place), meaning "Land of the Vajra".
