The beaches of North Goa attract vacationers from all over the globe. Many are highly developed with plenty of amenities like beach chairs and showers as well as nearby restaurants and cafes. The following are among Goa's not-to-be-missed beaches and are celebrated for their beauty and exciting water sports.

Calangute Beach

Calangute Beach is the star of Goa, which might be why it's referred to as the 'queen of beaches'. Just a few miles from the capital of Panaji, Calangute Beach is easily

Baga Beach
