Day 01 Jaipur







Jaipur's Most Famous, Peakless Temple Of Lord Krishna. It Is Situated In The Central Courtyard Of Jai-Niwas Garden Built To The East Of Chandramahal. The Idol Of The Tutelary Deity Govindji, Previously Installed In The Temple Of Vrindavan, Was Reinstalled Here By Sawai Jai Singh II As His Family Deity. Jaipur Also Called The Pink City Or Pink City, The City Palace Is A Blend Of Rajasthani And Mughal Styles, A Former Royal Residence Located In The Heart Of The Old City. Jantar Mantar, Observatory, Hawa Mahal, Albert Hall, Birla Mandir, And Local Market In The Evening.



Day 03 Jaipur to Jodhpur

We visit the Mehrangarh Fort – which stands four hundred feet above the skyline of Jodhpur. The fort is burnished in Red Sandstone and its colossal structure is surely impressive in all manner. Here we will see Moti Mahal – largest room in fort whose ceiling is decorated with Gold Leaves, Sea Shells and Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure dome of the Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative mirror palace with brightly coloured paintings, Silah Khana – place where weapons were stored, Daulat Khana – treasure vault and Rang Mahal. Later we visit Jaswant Thada – a royal cenotaph built in the white marble also known as Taj Mahal of Marwar. We then see the Sanganer Block Prints Demonstration – a hand-block printing technique originating from Sanganer. Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Jaswant Thadda, Toor ji ka Jhalra, Kaylana Lake.





Day 04 Jodhpur to Mount Abu

Today we explore, Ummaid Bhavan Palace Musuem – almost 75 years old architectural marvel now turned into museum showcasing artistic murals, opulent miniature paintings, vintage clocks and unusual household paraphernalia Ummaid Bhavan Palace, Ummaid Bhavan Mueseum .

Mount Abu is a hill station situated in the hills which is situated on a 22 km long and 9 km wide rocky plateau. Its highest peak is Guru Shikhar, 1,722 m (5,650 ft) high. 'Mount Abu', a mountainous place with natural coolness and vibrant forests, has been a summer mountain resort and a major tourist center of Western India. It is also a perfect mythological setting with a healthy climate. The signature artistry of architecture is also visible here. The attraction of Abu is that there is a fair every day, there is hustle and bustle of tourists all the time whether it is autumn or summer. Dilwara Temple is the main attraction here. Located on Guru Shikhar, 15 kilometers away from Mount Abu, these temples were built between the eleventh and thirteenth centuries. This magnificent temple is dedicated to the Ratithankaras of Jainism. The temples and sculptures of Dilwara are excellent examples of Indian architecture. Achalgarh Fort and Temple is situated 8 kilometers north-east of the temples of Dilwara and Guru Shikhar, the highest peak of the Aravalli mountain range, is situated 15 kilometers away. Apart from this, Nakki Lake, Gomukh Temple, Mount Abu Wildlife Sanctuary etc. are also worth seeing in Mount Abu.


