Mathura is a sacred city in Uttar Pradesh, northern India. The deity Lord Krishna is said to have been born on the site of Sri Krishna Janma Bhoomi, a Hindu temple. Dotting the Yamuna River are 25 ghats (flights of steps down to the water), of which Vishram Ghat is considered the holiest. Sati Burj is a 16th-century memorial tower. Dwarkadhish Temple has a carved entrance and a black-marble idol of Lord Krishna.

#### Radha Kund religious place of Mathura

Radha Kund is a very famous pilgrimage site in Mathura which is considered a major pilgrimage site for Vaishnavas in India. This city is one of the famous tourist places of Mathura. The history of Radha Kund dates back to the days of Radha and Krishna which tells about their love. Thousands of tourists come here every year to visit.

#### Govardhan Hill tourist place to be seen in Mathura

Govardhan Hill is located near Vrindavan, 22 km from Mathura, which is one of the most visited tourist places by the tourists coming here. This hill is mentioned in many ancient texts of Hinduism and is considered one of the major pilgrimage sites of Vaishnavas. According to history, once Lord Krishna had lifted Govardhan Hill on one of his fingers to save his village in Mathura from severe rain and storm. This mountain is considered very sacred and on the occasion of Guru Purnima, during Govardhan Puja, devotees undertake a devotional yatra by walking 23 kilometers barefoot around this mountain. After saving his village, Lord Krishna had asked all the people to worship this hill, that is why even today Govardhan Puja is performed a day after Diwali.
