Manali is a high-altitude Himalayan resort town in India's northern Himachal Pradesh state. It has a reputation as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. Set on the Beas River, it's a gateway for skiing in the Solang Valley and trekking in Parvati Valley. It's also a jumping-off point for paragliding, rafting and mountaineering in the Pir Panjal mountains, home to 4,000m-high Rohtang Pass.



Day 02- Manali Local Sightseeing



Manali is a town in the Kullu district of Himachal Pradesh, India, located in the Beas River valley. It's known for its cool climate, snow-capped mountains, and forests. Manali is also the starting point of an ancient trade route that goes through Lahul, Ladakh, and Kashmir, and is connected to Spiti by a divergent road. Manali is a popular tourist destination, and is known as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. It's a staging point for treks, such as Beas Kund and Chandrakhani Pass, and sports, such as white-water rafting. Manali is a year-round destination, but the best time to visit is from October to February to see the snow-covered mountains. From March to June, you can experience the nightlife.

Day 03 Manali - Rohtang Pass - Mahri - Manali

Marhi is a "shanty town" of roadside restaurants in Himachal Pradesh, India, located on the Manali-Leh Highway halfway between Manali and Rohtang La. Buses traveling on the highway often stop at Marhi so that passengers can eat. The settlement is seasonal, with most businesses closing for the winter

Day 04 Manali - Kullu - Manali



Kullu is a favorite destination of people during summer season. To escape the scorching heat of the plains, people take shelter in the Kullu Valley of Himachal Pradesh. The temples, apple orchards and Dussehra attract thousands of tourists to Kullu. The local handicrafts here are the biggest specialty of Kullu.

There are temples of the Hindu deities Rama, Krishna, and Vishnu. The area is well known for its hot springs and its beautiful landscape.
