Brahma Kapal is important for Pinddan Shraddh of ancestors (Pitrus). There are other interesting sightseeing spots like Mana, Vyas Gufa, Mata Murti, Charanpaduka, Bhimkund, and the “Mukh” of the Saraswati River. Just within the three km of Badrinath Ji. Mana Village: Inhabited by an Indo-Mongolian tribe, it is the last Indian village before Tibet.

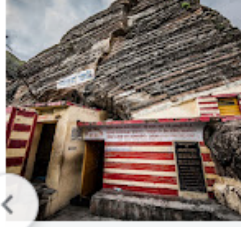

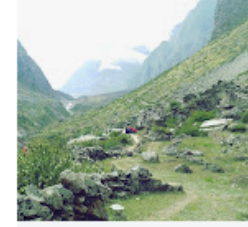

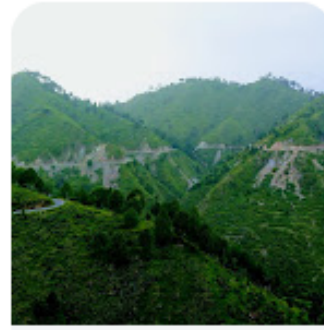
