Leh is the largest city and administrative capital of Ladakh, a high-altitude (3,524 m) city located in the Himalayas. It is known for its dramatic mountain scenery, dry climate, and the historical and cultural influence of Tibetan Buddhism. Leh was the former capital of the Ladakh Kingdom and is characterized by its unique Tibetan-style architecture, including the now-ruined Leh Palace.

Evening view: The local market has many showrooms, department stores, shops, restaurants and cafes. A Himachal Emporium selling handicraft products of Himachal Pradesh such as locally designed woolen clothes, branded clothes, pottery, wooden products and jewellery is also located here.

Leh is located in the Indus Valley, north of the river and surrounded by the Karakoram and Ladakh mountain ranges. The area is known for its high altitude, arid climate and sparse vegetation. Leh is part of the rain shadow region of the Himalayas, resulting in low annual rainfall. Leh was the capital of the Ladakh Kingdom and its influence can still be seen in the architecture of the Leh Palace, which is similar to the Potala Palace in Lhasa, Tibet. The region has a strong Tibetan cultural influence, with many monasteries and Buddhist temples. Leh has also been a hub of trade between India and Central Asia, with routes along the Silk Road and high passes leading to it.

Pangong Lake, also known as Pangong Tso, is a high-altitude, saline lake located in the Himalayas. It is famous for its changing color, appearing blue, gray-green and even red depending on the season and sunlight. According to Vajiram and Ravi, the lake is an important landmark, part of it is in India and the rest in China, and it is a

disputed territory between the two countries. Located in the Himalayas, Pangong Lake is located at an altitude of about 4,350 meters (14,270 feet) above sea level, making it one of the highest saltwater lakes in the world. Despite being a high-altitude lake, it is not a freshwater lake. It is a saline lake, meaning it has more salinity than freshwater but less than saltwater
