Day 01 Haridwar - Mussoorie - Barkot (September 17, 2025)



#### Pick up Location & Timing- Har Ki Pauri Parking, 07.30 AM

On Reaching Haridwar, We Were Welcomed By The WTP Official And We Left For Barkot. Morning meet our driver at Haridwar & drive for Barkot via Mussoorie, enroute visit Mussoorie Lake & Kempty Fall in Mussoorie. Later drive straight to Barkot. Check into the hotel arrival in Barkot.

Day 02- Barkot - Yamunotri- Barkot (September 18, 2025)



After breakfast we will drive to Yamnotri and return to Barkot. Drive to Jankichatti/Phoolchatti and from here do star trek to Yamunotri (6 km) (either on foot or by horse or doli at your own expense). After bathing in hot water of Jamunabai Kund and having "Darshan" of "Yamunaji" come back to Jankichatti by trek. Later drive to Barkot,

overnight stay at Barkot. After breakfast check out from Yamnotri hotel and drive to Barkot.

### Day 03- Barkot - Uttarkashi (September 19, 2025)



After breakfast check out from the Barkot. Drive to Uttarkashi. Check into the hotel arrival in Uttarkashi. Visit Kashi Vishwanath Temple in Uttarkashi. Overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

# Day 04 - Uttarkashi - Gangotri- Uttarkashi (September 20, 2025)



After breakfast we will drive to Gangotri and return to Uttarkashi. Rive to Gangotri, take holy bath in Garam Kund at Ganganani on the way, then drive to Gangotri through the beautiful Harsil valley. Harsil is famous for its natural beauty and spectacular views of pine trees and mountains. On reaching Shri Gangotri, take holy bath in the holy river Ganges, also known as Bhagirathi at its origin. Perform Puja and Darshan, then relax for some time in the beautiful environment. Later drive back to Uttarkashi.

# Day 05- Uttarkashi - Guptkashi (September 21, 2025)



After breakfast we leave Uttarkashi. Drive to Guptkashi via Moolgadh and Lambgaon. On the way you can see the beautiful Mandakini river at Tilwara. Mandakini river comes from Kedarnath, drive along the river to reach Guptkashi, visit Ardh Narishwar temple at Guptkashi. Check out hotel arrival at Guptkashi

# Day 06 - Guptkashi to Kedarnath (September 22, 2025)



Early morning after breakfast departure for Kedarnath Dham. Enjoy Kedarnath Darshan.

By Helicopter: Morning our driver will drop you your pre-book Helipad. You can inform the driver about your arrival time whether it will be by helicopter or by trek, so that Driver will be there to pick you up. (Note: helicopter ticket is not included in this package).

By Trek: Morning our driver will transfer you to Sonprayag then you have to take a local jeep for Gaurikund & then your trek starts for Kedarnath Ji. After darshan, you follow the same & return to Sonpraag. There is a big parking issue so the driver will go back to another palace if his contact no. is not working then you have to arrange another taxi or wait for your driver.

Kedarnath: The Kedarnath shrine, one of the 12 jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva, is a scenic spot situated, against the backdrop of the majestic Kedarnath range. Kedar is another name of Lord Shiva. According to legend, the Pandavas after having won over the Kaurava in the Kurukshetra war, feel guilty of having killed their own brothers and sought the blessings of Lord Shiva for ransom. He eluded them repeatedly and while fleeing took refuge at Kedarnath in the form of a bull. On being followed he dived into the ground, leaving his hump on the surface.

Kedarnath Weather: – Due to its high elevation, the weather in Kedarnath remains cold for the most part of the year. Summer here is cool and agreeable while winter is severe. During the summer season, the temperature varies around 20°Celsius. Light woolen wear is recommended. The Winter season in Kedarnath is severe with the mercury falling to as low as 0°Celsius. During this time the place experiences snowfall as well. Due to the extreme chilly climatic conditions, this time is usually avoided by tourists.

## Day 07- Kedarnath - Guptkashi (September 23, 2025)



The morning after darshan, return to Guptkashi, by Track or helicopter.

# Day 08 - Guptkashi to Badrinath (September 24, 2025)



The morning after breakfast, move to Badrinath. Check in to the hotel arrival in Badrinath. Pilgrims after having a bath in the Tapt Kund have the Darshan of Badrivishal & Aarti in the evening. Brahma Kapal is important for Pinddan Shraddh of ancestors (Pitrus). There are other interesting sightseeing spots like Mana, Vyas Gufa, Mata Murti, Charanpaduka, Bhimkund, and the "Mukh" of the Saraswati River. Just within the three km of Badrinath Ji. Mana Village: Inhabited by an Indo-Mongolian tribe, it is the last Indian village before Tibet.

### Day 09- Badrinath to Srinagar (September 25, 2025)



After breakfast we will drive to Srinagar and back to Srinagar. Wake up in the morning and enjoy the morning of Uttarakhand. Have breakfast and leave for Srinagar which is a very beautiful city of Uttarakhand. Srinagar is also an important tourist attraction for its natural beauty and many temples. One of the important temples of Srinagar is Kamleshwar Mahadev dedicated to Lord Shiva. Kilkileshwar Mahadev is another important temple on the banks of the Alaknanda River. This temple was founded by Adi Shankaracharya. Dhari Devi Temple Dhari Devi is located on the banks of the Alaknanda River between Srinagar and Rudraprayag in the Garhwal region of Uttarakhand, India. Overnight stay in Srinagar

## Day 10- Srinagar to Rishikesh Local Sightseeing and Departure Haridwar - End of the Tour (September 26, 2025)



Rishikesh (Tadbhava: Rishikesh) is situated on the right bank of the Ganges River and is a pilgrimage site for Hindus, where ancient sages used to meditate in search of higher knowledge. Many temples and ashrams are built along the river. Rishikesh is a vegetarian and alcohol-free town. It is a popular yoga destination. Rishikesh is the starting point for the Chota Char Dham pilgrimage places like Badrinath, Kedarnath, Gangotri and Yamunotri and Himalayan tourist places like Harsil, Chopta, Auli and famous summer and winter trekking destinations like Dodital, Dayara Bugyal, Kedarkanth, Har Ki Doon Valley for camping and panoramic views of the majestic Himalayas.
