



# Day 01 Manali




On reaching Manali, welcomed by WTP officials and checked in at hotel, freshened up and toured the city.

It's a staging point for treks, such as Beas Kund and Chandrakhani Pass, and sports, such as white-water rafting. Manali is a year-round destination, but the best time to visit is from October to February to see the snow-covered mountains. From March to June, you can experience the nightlife.

Some of the top attractions in Kasol include Tosh Village, the Parvati Valley, Kheer Ganga, and the Parvati River. The Kasol market is also a must-visit for its eclectic flea market atmosphere. 
