Govardhan Hill tourist place to be seen in Mathura


Govardhan Hill is located near Vrindavan, 22 km from Mathura, which is one of the most visited tourist places by the tourists coming here. This hill is mentioned in many ancient texts of Hinduism and is considered one of the major pilgrimage sites of Vaishnavas. According to history, once Lord Krishna had lifted Govardhan Hill on one of his fingers to save his village in Mathura from severe rain and storm. This mountain is considered very sacred and on the occasion of Guru Purnima, during Govardhan Puja, devotees undertake a devotional yatra by walking 23 kilometers barefoot around this mountain. After saving his village, Lord Krishna had asked all the people to worship this hill, that is why even today Govardhan Puja is performed a day after Diwali.



Day 04- Mathura - Vrindavan



Vrindavan is a holy town in Uttar Pradesh, northern India. The Hindu deity Krishna is said to have spent his childhood here. It's home to temples, many dedicated to Krishna and his lover, the deity Radha. At Banke Bihari Temple, the curtain in front of Krishna's statue is opened and closed every few minutes. At Radha Raman Temple, a gold plate beside Krishna signifies Radha. Prem Mandir is a huge white marble temple.





Day 05- Vrindavan Local Sightseeing




