Day 01 Jaipur or Chandigarh or Delhi - Shimla

The Gaiety Theatre, modelled on the old British theatre, is now a centre of cultural activities. The Mall can also be reached by HPPVN lift from Cart Road. - Kali Bari Temple, Circa-1845 hilltop temple accessible by stairs & popular for picturesque mountain views.
- Mall Road, Scenic main road allowing pedestrian traffic only to visit its plentiful shops, eateries & hotels.

Day 02- Shimla - Kufri - Shimla



Kufri, along with Chail and Shimla, form the famous Golden Triangle of Himachal Pradesh. The annual Winter Sports Festival is held here in February. Kufri has become the center of all kinds of snow sports. It is a bit difficult to reach the high peaks of Kufri, for this tourists can ride a pony. Some places worth visiting in Kufri: Jakhu Temple: This temple is one of the places worth visiting for spiritual tourists. The temple houses one of the tallest statues in the world, the figure of the Hindu deity Anubhav. Kufri Fun Campus: This park is equipped with various rides, pools and the world's highest go-kart track. During this time, there is snowfall at tourist places like Shimla as well as Kufri, Nal Dehra, Chail etc. The city of Kufri was founded by the British in the year 1819.
