


Honeymoon from Chandigarh to Manali and Shimla

Dinner

Chandigarh, the capital of the northern Indian states of Punjab and Haryana, was designed by the Swiss-French modernist architect, Le Corbusier. His buildings include the Capitol Complex with its High Court, Secretariat and Legislative Assembly, as well as the giant Open Hand Monument. The nearby Rock Garden is a park featuring sculptures made of stones, recycled ceramics and industrial relics.






Day 02- Transfer from Chandigarh to Shimla



Shimla's main shopping centre, which also has restaurants. The Gaiety Theatre, modelled on the old British theatre, is now a centre of cultural activities. The Mall can also be reached by HPPVN lift from Cart Road. Lakkar Bazaar near the Ridge is famous for wooden items and souvenirs. Overnight stay in Shimla



Day 03- Shimla - Kufri -Shimla



Kufri, along with Chail and Shimla form the famous Golden Triangle of Himachal Pradesh. The annual winter sports festival is held here in February. Kufri has become a center for all types of snow sports. It is a bit difficult to reach the high peaks of Kufri, for this tourists can ride a pony.

Some places to visit in Kufri:

Jakhu Temple: This temple is one of the places to visit for spiritual tourists. The temple houses one of the tallest statues in the world, a figure of the Hindu god Hanuman. Kufri Fun Campus: This park is equipped with various rides, pools and the world's highest go-kart track.

During this period, along with Shimla, there is snowfall in tourist places like Kufri, Nal Dehra, Chail etc.

Kufri city was established by the British in the year 1819. Before this it was under Nepal. It is said that the British used to come here during summer to hunt and get relief from the heat.

Day 04- Transfer from Shimla to Manali



Manali is a high-altitude Himalayan resort town in India's northern Himachal Pradesh state. It has a reputation as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. Set on the Beas River, it's a gateway for skiing in the Solang Valley and trekking in Parvati Valley. It's also a jumping-off point for paragliding, rafting and mountaineering in the Pir Panjal mountains, home to 4,000m-high Rohtang Pass.
