- Jantar Mantar is a collection of 19 astronomical instruments built by Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur, Rajasthan.
- Hawa Maha, India. Built of red and pink sandstone, this palace is located on the edge of the City Palace of Jaipur.
- Govind Dev Ji Temple is a major Hindu temple located in Jaipur, Rajasthan, dedicated to Lord Krishna and Radha Rani.

- Birla Mandir, Jaipur (Lakshmi Narayan Temple) is a Hindu temple located in Jaipur, India and is one of many Birla mandirs.
- Chokhi-Dhani If you wish, you can visit a traditional Rajasthani village in the evening (Self-Pay).

Sightseeing For The Day

- The Nahargarh Fort is located on the edge of the Aravalli Hills and towers over the city of Jaipur
- Jal Mahal (Water Palace) is a palace located in the middle of the Man Sagar Lake in the city of Jaipur
- Maotha Lake is an artificial (man-made) lake located below the Amer Fort near Jaipur
- Panna Meena Ka Kund is a historic stepwell and rain water harvesting site
- The Amer Palace is made of sandstone and marble and has intricate carvings and mirror work.
- Jaipur Elephant Village, established as a conservation effort for retired and rescued elephants.
- If time permits, Jaipur's local markets offer a varied shopping experience.

The light and sound show is not a video display of the fort façade but a poignant commentary and light show on the façade. The narration is excellent and extremely informative. It is a wonderful experience and a must-see when visiting Jaipur (if you like).

Day 03 Jaipur - Jodhpur



We Visit The Mehrangarh Fort – Which Stands Four Hundred Feet Above The Skyline Of Jodhpur. The Fort Is Burnished In Red Sandstone And Its Colossal Structure Is Surely Impressive In All Manner. Here We Will See Moti Mahal – Largest Room In Fort Whose Ceiling Is Decorated With Gold Leaves, Sea Shells And Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure Dome Of The Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative Mirror Palace With Brightly Coloured Paintings, Silah Khana – Place Where Weapons Were Stored, Daulat Khana – Treasure Vault And Rang Mahal. Later We Visit Jaswant Thada – A Royal Cenotaph Built In The White Marble Also Known As Taj Mahal Of Marwar. We Then See The Sanganeri Block Prints Demonstration – A Hand-block Printing Technique Originating From Sanganer. Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Jaswant Thadda, Toor Ji Ka Jhalra, Kaylana Lake. Noght Stay in Jodhpur

Sightseeing For The Day

- Mehrangarh is a historical fort located in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India.
- Jaswant Thada is a white marble monument located near the Mehrangarh Fort in Jodhpur.
- Ghantaghar (Ghadiyal), This tourist attraction is a beautiful clock tower with a working clock mechanism and offers a view of the Mehrangarh Fort.
- Toorji Ka Jhalra Bavdi, Popular for photos, this restored 18th-century stepwell features intricate sandstone carvings.
- The vibrant local market around the Clock Tower is also worth a visit (if there is time).
- Mandore Garden, This garden is full of beautiful architecture, monuments and temples and is a peaceful place to spend time with family
- Informative light and sound show at Mandore Gardens (if you like).

Day 04 Jodhpur - Jaisalmer



Jodhpur Sightseeing for the day

- The Umaid Bhawan Museum is mesmerizing. It gives a glimpse of the royal lifestyle and amazing architecture
- Kaylana Lake, Built in the 19th century, this artificial lake offers boating, bird watching and sunset views.

Transfer to Jaisalmer after visiting Jodhpur, Night stay in jaisalmer.

- Jaisalmer War Museum, Patriotic museum showcasing information & history about the Indian Army & the wars it has fought.
- Gadisar Lake, Created in the 14th century, this lake is now known for its temples, shrines & migratory birds.

Day 05 Jaisalmer Explore - Jaisalmer Desert Enjot



Today we explore Jaisalmer City. We visit Golden Fort – a UNESCO world heritage site and one of the very few living forts in the world, as nearly one fourth the population of the city still resides within the Fort followed by visit to Jain Mandir – craved in yellow sandstones dedicated to Jain hermits known as Tirthankars. Later we visit Patwon ki Haweli Museum – Palace built in early 1800s, now a museum featuring intricate carvings, furniture and artwork and see Nathmalji ki haveli. It's time to visit Kuldhara – an abandoned village believed to be cursed. We then proceed to famous Sam Sand Dunes. Upon arrival we experience thrilling Dune Bashing over the golden sands of Jaisalmer.

Sightseeing for the day

- Jaisalmer Fort, Massive, 12th-century fortified city featuring ornate Jain temples with idols & stone carvings.
- Kothari's Patwon Ki Haveli, Series of early-1800s palaces, now a museum featuring intricate carvings, furniture & artwork.
- Salam Singh Ki Haweli (Moti Mahal), Architecturally notable residence built in 1815 with a peacock-shaped roof & numerous balconies.
- Nathmal Ki Haveli, Privately owned 19th-century haveli known for ornate exterior carvings & unique architecture.
- BADA BAGH, Series of ornate stone cenotaphs dedicated to the royal family, dating to the 16th century.
- Vyas Chhatri, Rajasthani-style sandstone cenotaph of the sage Vyas, who wrote the Mahabharata epic.

Transfer to Jaisalmer Desert after visiting Jaisalmer

In the evening we get to witness the stunning beauty of the sandy terrain by riding a camel and watching the sunset cast a reddish orange hue on the desert horizon. Later we enjoy traditional Rajasthani folk dance along with dinner. **Night Stay in Jaisalmer Camp**
