Manali is a town in the Kullu district of Himachal Pradesh, India, located in the Beas River valley. It's known for its cool climate, snow-capped mountains, and forests. Manali is also the starting point of an ancient trade route that goes through Lahul, Ladakh, and Kashmir, and is connected to Spiti by a divergent road. Manali is a popular tourist destination, and is known as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. It's a staging point for treks, such as Beas Kund and Chandrakhani Pass, and sports, such as white-water rafting. Manali is a year-round destination, but the best time to visit is from October to February to see the snow-covered mountains. From March to June, you can experience the nightlife. Sightseen for the day

- Hadimba Devi Temple, This 1500s Hindu temple built of wood in a cedar forest has intricate carvings & a shrine.
- Manu Temple, This historical Hindu temple in a serene setting backdropped by mountains is accessible by foot.
- Nehru Kund, Visitors can drink at this freshwater spring in a picturesque mountain environment.
- Van Vihar National Park, National park in a tree-filled riverfront setting with a variety of animals in natural habitats.

Manali Mall Road has many showrooms, departmental stores, shops, restaurants and cafes. There is also a Himachal Emporium which sells handicraft products from Himachal Pradesh, such as locally designed woollen clothes, branded clothes, pottery, wooden products and jewellery.
