Manali is a popular tourist destination, and is known as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. It's a staging point for treks, such as Beas Kund and Chandrakhani Pass, and sports, such as white-water rafting. Manali is a year-round destination, but the best time to visit is from October to February to see the snow-covered mountains. From March to

June, you can experience the nightlife.




