Day 03 Jaipur - Pushkar

Ajmer Is A Major And Historical City Of Rajasthan State Of India. It Is Also The Headquarters Of Ajmer District. The City Is Famous For Its Many Ancient Monuments Like Brahma Temple (the Only One In The World), Taragarh Fort, Adhai-Din Ka-Jhopra, Dargah Of Moinuddin Chishti And Jain Temples Etc. Ajmer Plays An Important Role In The Map Of India. Historic Ajmer Attracts Pilgrims And Tourists From Across The Country And Abroad. Ajmer Lives With Traditions Of Religion And Cultures, Dargah Of Moinuddin Chishti, Jain Temples, Taragarh Fort, Adhai-Din Ka-Jhopra.



Pushkar Is A City And Major Hindu Pilgrimage Site Located In Ajmer District In The Indian State Of Rajasthan. The Famous Pushkar Fair Is Held Here Every Year And The Countries Only Brahma Temple Is Located Here. Pushkar Is Considered The Mouth Of Pilgrimages. Just As Prayag Is Called "Tirthraj", Similarly This Pilgrimage Is Called "Pushkarraj". Brahma Mandir (English: Brahma Temple) Is An Indian Hindu Temple Located In The Holy City Of Pushkar In The Ajmer District Of Rajasthan State Of India. Is Located At. The Idol Of Lord Brahma Is Installed In This Temple, Brahma Temple, Savitri Mata Temple, Pushkar Sarover.

Day 04 Pushkar - Jodhpur

We visit the Mehrangarh Fort – which stands four hundred feet above the skyline of Jodhpur. The fort is burnished in Red Sandstone and its colossal structure is surely impressive in all manner. Here we will see Moti Mahal – largest room in fort whose ceiling is decorated with Gold Leaves, Sea Shells and Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure dome of the Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative mirror palace with brightly coloured paintings, Silah Khana – place where weapons were stored, Daulat Khana – treasure vault and Rang Mahal. Later we visit Jaswant Thada – a royal cenotaph built in the white marble also known as Taj Mahal of Marwar. We then see the Sanganeri Block Prints Demonstration – a hand-block printing technique originating from Sanganer. Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Jaswant Thadda, Toor ji ka Jhalra, Kaylana Lake.





Day 05 Jodhpur - Jaisalmer



Jaisalmer, Today We Proceed To Jaisalmer – Golden City Of Desert Famed For Its Yellow Sandstone Architecture. Upon Arrival We Take Blissful Boat Ride In Gadisar Lake Surrounded By Many Temples, Shrines And Ghats. Later We Enjoy Delightful Puppet Show – A Preserved Ancient Folk Art Of Rajasthan.

Later We Visit Patwon Ki Haweli Museum – Palace Built In Early 1800s, Now A Museum Featuring Intricate Carvings, Furniture And Artwork And See Nathmalji Ki Haveli. It's Time To Visit Kuldhara – An Abandoned Village Believed To Be Cursed. We Then Proceed To Famous Sam Sand Dunes. Upon Arrival We Experience Thrilling Dune Bashing Over The Golden Sands Of Jaisalmer.







Day 07 Camp - Mount Abu


Mount Abu is a hill station situated in the hills which is situated on a 22 km long and 9 km wide rocky plateau. Its highest peak is Guru Shikhar, 1,722 m (5,650 ft) high. 'Mount Abu', a mountainous place with natural coolness and vibrant forests, has been a summer mountain resort and a major tourist center of Western India. It is also a perfect mythological setting with a healthy climate. The signature artistry of architecture is also visible here. The attraction of Abu is that there is a fair every day, there is hustle and bustle of tourists all the time whether it is autumn or summer. Dilwara Temple is the main attraction here. Located on Guru Shikhar, 15 kilometers away from Mount Abu, these temples were built between the eleventh and thirteenth centuries. This magnificent temple is dedicated to the Ratithankaras of Jainism. The temples and sculptures of Dilwara are excellent examples of Indian architecture. Achalgarh Fort and Temple is situated 8 kilometers north-east of the temples of Dilwara and Guru Shikhar, the highest peak of the Aravalli mountain range, is situated 15 kilometers away. Apart from this, Nakki Lake, Gomukh Temple, Mount Abu Wildlife Sanctuary etc. are also worth seeing in Mount Abu.





Day 08 Mount Abu - Haldighati - Udaipur


Maharana Pratap's horse Chetak played a pivotal role in the Battle of Haldighati. Chetak was fatally wounded in this battle and died on 18 June 1576. Maharana Pratap erected a small monument for his horse at the place where Chetak fell down. The cenotaph still exists at Haldighati. Haldighati is also known for its charity rose product and the mud art of Molela. Much emphasis is being laid for promoting a private cottage industry by the Department of Tourism.





Day 09 Explore Udaipur

Udaipur, known as the city of lakes, is considered to be the most attractive tourist city of North India. There is a lot to attract tourists here. The unique confluence of desert and lakes is not seen anywhere else. This city is located near the Aravalli Hills in Rajasthan.
