Day 01: Dehradun Arrival



Dinner

On reaching Dehradun, we were welcomed by the WTP official and we checked in to the hotel, freshened up and rested.

- This is the day of reporting at Dehradun, which is our main base (start and end point) for the heli-tour.
- World Trip Plan arranges extra night stay for passengers, which includes dinner and breakfast, so that they can rest and be fully prepared for the journey ahead.
- Passengers will be picked up from Dehradun Airport/Railway Station/Bus Stand as per their arrival time.
- In the evening, there will be a Tour Briefing (mandatory to attend) by our Dehradun team, which will be conducted at around 1900 Hrs. Duffel bags will be provided during the tour briefing, in which necessary luggage will have to be packed by the passengers “Maximum 5 kg/person will be permitted.

Please note: Our staff will be taking the body weight of each pilgrim during the tour briefing; hence kindly ensure you attend the same.

Day 02: Dehradun - Yamunotri



Breakfast



Dinner

- This is the starting day of the Chardham yatra. Passengers will check-out from the hotel at 06:30 am, after an early morning breakfast. They will be picked-up from the Hotel by our team & taken to Sahastradhara Helidrome.
- Heli has its own Heli-base in Kharsali, where our ground staff would welcome the passengers. The staff will then get the passengers settled in the hotel, which is at a walking distance from the helipad.
- After reaching the hotel, the passengers will be taken for darshan as soon as possible, to avoid the yatra rush.
- Approximate time taken for Yamunotri Temple Darshan: Approximately 05hrs 30mins (round-trip). Yamunotri trek is 06 km one-way.
- Sightseeing at Kharsali: Hot Spring at Yamunotri Temple, Yamuna Mata Temple, and Shani Temple.

Please Note: Since, Kharsali village is the least developed destination among the Chardhams. Hotel accommodation will be basic.

Day 03: Yamunotri - Gangotri

 Breakfast  Dinner

- Fly to Harsil Helipad.
- Visit Gangotri Temple by car (about 25 km one way).
- Enjoy the scenic Harsil valley.

Overnight stay at Harsil.

Day 04: Gangotri - Kedarnath

 Breakfast  Dinner

Fly to Phata or Guptkashi helipad, then shuttle to Kedarnath.

Darshan at Kedarnath Temple.

Overnight stay at Guptkashi or near Kedarnath (depending on package).

Day 05 Kedarnath - Badrinath - Dehradun



Breakfast

- Fly to Badrinath.
- Darshan at Badrinath Temple.
- Return to Dehradun by evening.

End of Yatra.

- Helicopter flight from Dehradun to Chardham pilgrimage sites, and return.
- Travel in a comfortable AC vehicle as per the itinerary (AC is not working in hilly area).
- Room sharing as per the package.
- Accommodation in comfortable and convenient hotels.
- VIP Darshan.
- Meals mentioned in the itinerary.
- Accommodation in listed hotels/similar hotels.
- Sightseeing as per itinerary.
- Transportation - Entire journey by private vehicle.
- All applicable taxes like hotel tax, transport tax, all toll taxes, parking charges and driver allowances are included.
- Larger/smaller vehicle will be provided as per the size of the group.

What you should verify / keep in mind

- Helipad & transfer logistics: For example at Kedarnath youâ€™ll land at a helipad (Sersi/Guptkashi) and then shuttle or heli to the shrine. Make sure your package states the exact helipads used.
- Weight and baggage limits: Helicopter packages often restrict weight and baggage (both for safety and high-altitude operations).
- Weather & delays: Helicopter flights in Himalayan regions are more prone to cancellation or delay due to weather. Have buffer time.
- Registration / official ticketing: Use authorized operators. There have been reports of fraud in â€œheli yatraâ€• bookings in Uttarakhand.
- Safety & approvals: Ensure the operator has appropriate approvals and is recognized by the state and aviation authority.
- Accommodation & meals: Check whatâ€™s included â€” the heli package often includes stay, meals, transfers, VIP darshan etc. But specifics vary.
- Altitude & acclimatisation: Even via helicopter you gain altitude fast; though less trekking, still be prepared (health, hydration).
- Start point & time: Usually you begin early from Dehradun helipad; check what time you must report.

Is it worth it? Pros & Cons

Pros

- Saves lots of time compared to the traditional road + trek route.
- Reduces fatigue (especially beneficial if travelling with older people or those less fit).
- Unique experience of flying over Himalayan terrain.
- Often VIP-darshan/quicker access included in such packages.

Cons

- Significant cost compared to road travel.
- Might feel rushed (less â€œjourneyâ€• time, more focus on destination). Some travellers feel the spiritual â€œslowâ€• aspect is reduced.

- Dependent on weather; possibility of flight cancellations.
- For Kedarnath especially, although you land near by via heli, there still may be short transfers or steps. So not absolutely zero exertion.

Our Specialty

- Insurance charges are not included in the tour (But insurance is a must).

Transport Service

- All transfers and sightseeing will be done by A/C vehicle as per the size of the tour group

Special Notes

- During the trip, guests are requested to bring 2 photocopies (Xerox) of any photo ID card (except PAN card) like Passport/Driving License/Voter ID/Aadhaar Card. Submit one copy of it at the time of booking.
- Children/Students are requested to bring 2 photocopies (Xerox) of their school or college photo ID card. Submit one copy of it at the time of booking.
- Bring 2 passport size photographs for infants.
- NRI guests are requested to bring a copy of their passport and visa.

Important Notes

- In case of low bookings, all USTs such as MFL, Second Innings, Honeymoon etc. will be merged with Family Tours to operate the tour at maximum capacity. Although we take pride in keeping our schedule consistent, the above mentioned schedule is subject to change without any prior notice.
- Given the current pandemic situation, some of the sightseeing spots may be temporarily closed without any prior notice, in which case we will try to shift to an alternate sightseeing spot if possible.
