Day 02- Amritsar Local Sightseeing

Amritsar is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, 28 kilometers from the border with Pakistan. At the center of its walled old town, the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib) is the holiest gurdwara (religious complex) of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar tank (lake), where pilgrims bathe.

• Vaisnodevi temple is located near Katra city of Jammu in the state of Jammu and Kashmir. It is one of the most revered holy sites in Northern India. • Vaishno Devi Temple is located at a distance of about 14 kilometers from Katra. • The temple is visited by millions of pilgrims every year and is one of the most prominent and visited pilgrimage sites in India. • Here people climb 14 km to reach the building. Many facilities like horse, pithu, palanquin, helicopter, tram, ropeway are available here. • Also known for shopping of Katra, Lehenga, Chunni, Salwar, Suit. • The temple of Kali Maa is also very famous here. • Katra is also associated with the heroic stories of freedom fighters. • On August 9, 1942, a demonstration took place outside Katra Neel. • Katra is the base camp for Vaishno Devi trek. • There is a temple of nine goddesses at a distance of about 10 kilometers from Katra. • Amar Mahal Museum, Bagh-e-Bahu Park, and Mansar Lake can also be seen in Katra.

Day 05: Katra - Patnitop - Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, proceed for Patnitop, a famous Hill Resort (95 Kms/3-4 Hours drive from Katra) which is perched on a beautiful plateau, at an altitude of 2024 meters across which the Jammu – Srinagar Highway passes. Visit the famous Nag Temple, Padora Enclave & Patnitop park. In the afternoon, proceed for Sanasar (20 Kms/1.0 Hour) which is a cup shaped meadow surrounded by gigantic conifers. En route visit Nathatop, another famous tourist point. One can experience the beauty of the Sanasar valley by gliding over its landscapes and meadows and a lake too. A low flying ride here usually includes a larger bit of the flight path over a lake and a landing into the meadows. High flying ride can be experienced at Nathatop upto a duration of 20 minutes. Back to Patnitop in the evening. Overnight stay at Patnitop.



Day 06 Patnitop - Pahalgam

Transfer journey from Pahalgam to Srinagar

The main attraction of Dal Lake is the shikaras or houseboats here. Tourists can enjoy the lake by staying in these houseboats. Nehru Park, islands like Kanatur Khana, Charchinari etc. and Hazrat Bal can also be visited during these trips. Apart from this, shops are also set up on shikaras and various types of items can be purchased while riding on the shikaras. Various types of vegetation further enhance the beauty of the lake. Lotus flowers and water lilies flowing in the water add to the beauty of the lake. Various types of recreational facilities like kayaking, canoeing, water surfing and angling are made available here for the tourists. Apart from tourism, fishing is mainly done in Dal Lake.
