- Jantar Mantar is a collection of 19 astronomical instruments built by Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur, Rajasthan.
- Hawa Mahal is a palace located in the city of Jaipur, Rajasthan, India. Built of red and pink sandstone, this palace is located on the edge of the City Palace of Jaipur.
- Govind Dev Ji Temple is a major Hindu temple located in Jaipur, Rajasthan, dedicated to Lord Krishna and Radha Rani.

Jaipur's most famous, peakless temple of Lord Krishna. It is situated in the central courtyard of Jai-Niwas garden built to the east of Chandramahal. The idol of the tutelary deity Govindji, previously installed in the temple of Vrindavan, was reinstalled here by Sawai Jai Singh II as his family deity. Jaipur Also called the Pink City or Pink City, the City Palace is a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal styles, a former royal residence located in the heart of the old city. Jantar Mantar, Observatory, Hawa Mahal, Albert Hall, Birla Mandir, and local market in the evening.

Sightseeing For The Day

- Amer Fort, is a hill fort located in the Amer area of Jaipur, the capital of the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is a major tourist attraction of the city of Jaipur.
- Panna Meena Ka Kund is near Ambikeshwar Mahadev Temple in Amer town.
- The Ambikeshwar Mahadev Temple is a famous place to visit in Jaipur.
- There is a small island in the middle of the Mawtha lake on which there is also a garden. It is called Kesar Kyari because once fragrant saffron was sown in it, which used to make the atmosphere near the palace fragrant.
- Birla Mandir, Jaipur (Lakshmi Narayan Temple) This temple is part of the series of paintings built by the Birla Group.
- Moti Dungri Temple is situated at the foothills of Moti Dungri Fort.

We Visit The Mehrangarh Fort – Which Stands Four Hundred Feet Above The Skyline Of Jodhpur. The Fort Is Burnished In Red Sandstone And Its Colossal Structure Is Surely Impressive In All Manner. Here We Will See Moti Mahal – Largest Room In Fort Whose Ceiling Is Decorated With Gold Leaves, Sea Shells And Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure Dome Of The Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative Mirror Palace With Brightly Coloured Paintings, Silah Khana – Place Where Weapons Were Stored, Daulat Khana – Treasure Vault And Rang Mahal. Later We Visit Jaswant Thada – A Royal Cenotaph Built In The White Marble Also Known As Taj Mahal Of Marwar. We Then See The Sanganeri Block Prints Demonstration – A Hand-block Printing Technique Originating From Sanganer. Mehrangarh Fort, Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, Jaswant Thadda, Toor Ji Ka Jhalra, Kaylana Lake.

Sightseeing For The Day

- Mehrangarh is a historical fort located in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India.
- Jaswant Thada is a white marble monument located near the Mehrangarh Fort in Jodhpur.
- Mandore Garden, People say this garden offers beautiful architecture, cenotaphs, and temples, and is a peaceful place to spend time with family. They also highlight the affordable entry fee, the fun toy train ride, and the informative light and sound show.
- Ghantaghar (Clockhouse), This tourist attraction is a beautiful clock tower with a working clock mechanism and a view of the Mehrangarh Fort. Apart from this, the vibrant local market around the clock tower is also worth visiting.
- The Umaid Bhawan Museum is mesmerizing. It gives a glimpse of the royal lifestyle and amazing architecture
- Toorji Ka Jhalra Bavdi, Popular for photos, this restored 18th-century stepwell features intricate sandstone carvings.
- Kaylana Lake, Built in the 19th century, this artificial lake offers boating, bird watching and sunset views.
