Day 01 Jaipur (August 14, 2025)



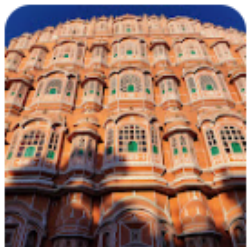

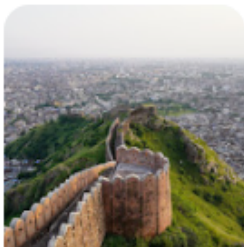

Jaipur's most famous, peakless temple of Lord Krishna. It is situated in the central courtyard of Jai-Niwas garden built to the east of Chandramahal. The idol of the tutelary deity Govindji, previously installed in the temple of Vrindavan, was reinstalled here by Sawai Jai Singh II as his family deity. Jaipur Also called the Pink City or Pink City, the City Palace is a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal styles, a former royal residence located in the heart of the old city. Evening Stroll: Jaipur has many vibrant local markets that offer a unique shopping experience. Popular markets include Johri Bazaar, known for its fine jewellery; Chandpole Bazaar, famous for handicrafts and marble crafts; and Tripolia Bazaar, a hub for bangles and traditional Rajasthani costumes. Bapu Bazaar is another popular market that sells a wide range of Rajasthani goods, including leather products and textiles.

Here We Will See Moti Mahal – Largest Room In Fort Whose Ceiling Is Decorated With Gold Leaves, Sea Shells And Mirrors, Phool Mahal – Pleasure Dome Of The Maharajas, Sheesh Mahal – Decorative Mirror Palace With Brightly Coloured Paintings, Silah Khana – Place Where Weapons Were Stored, Daulat Khana – Treasure Vault And Rang Mahal. Later We Visit Jaswant Thada – A Royal Cenotaph Built In The White Marble Also Known As Taj Mahal Of Marwar. We Then See The Sanganeri Block Prints Demonstration – A Hand-block Printing Technique Originating From Sanganer. 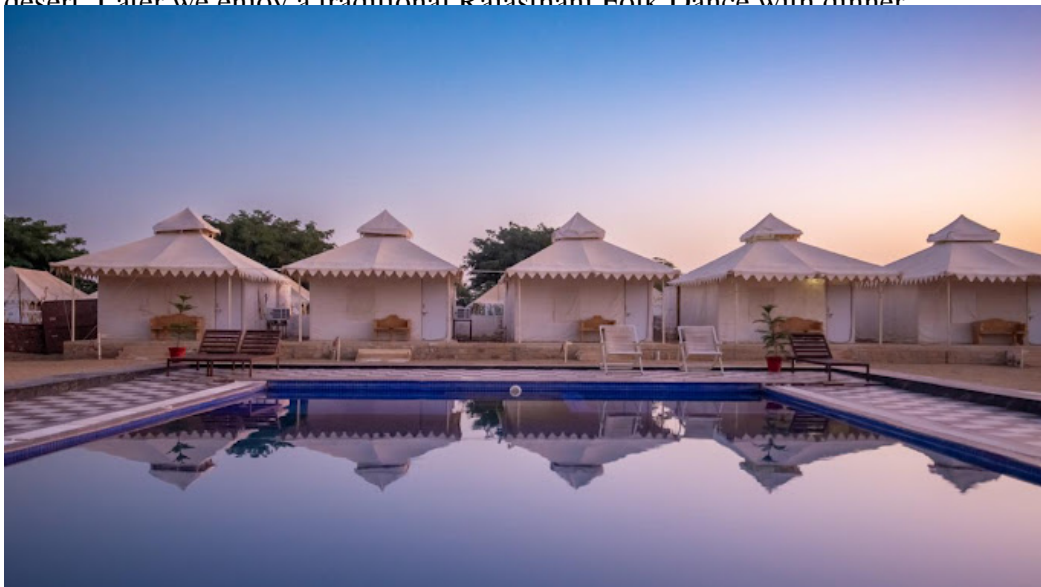
