Day 04 Sariska Tiger Reserve Safari

Sariska Tiger Reserve is one of the most famous national parks in India. Sariska Tiger Reserve has a wide range of wildlife including tiger, leopard, panther, wild cat, caracal, striped badger, golden jackal, chital, sambar, nilgai, chinkara, four-horned antelope, wild boar, rabbit, langur and many bird species and reptiles. The tiger population had disappeared from here in 2005, but after starting the tiger rehabilitation program in 2008, there are now five tigers here. The number of tigers has increased to 11 in July 2014, which includes 9 adults and 2 cubs. The dominant tree in the forests is Dhok (Anogeissus pendula). Other trees are Salar (Boswellia serrata), Kadaya (Sterculia urens), Dhak (Butea monosperma), Gol (Lannea coromandelica), Ber (Ziziphus mauritiana) and Khair (Acacia catechu). In some places, banyan (Ficus benghalensis), arjun (Terminalia arjuna), guggul (Commiphora wightii) or bamboo may also be used. Shrubs are also numerous, such as kair (Capparis decidua), adusta (Adhatoda vesica) and jhar ber (Ziziphus nummularia), (safari charge self-pay)
