Dwarka is an ancient city in the northwestern Indian state of Gujarat. It is known as a Hindu pilgrimage site. The ancient Dwarkadhish Temple has an elaborately tiered main shrine, a carved entrance and a black-marble idol of Lord Krishna. Dwarka Beach and nearby Dwarka Lighthouse offer views of the Arabian Sea. Southeast, Gaga Wildlife Sanctuary protects migratory birds and endangered species like the Indian wolf. Dwarka, a sacred Hindu city located in Gujarat, India, is believed to be the mythical capital of Lord Krishna, and is one of the four sacred pilgrimage sites (Char Dham). It is located on the western coast where the Gomti River meets the Arabian Sea, and is known for the Dwarkadhish Temple and its underwater archaeological significance.

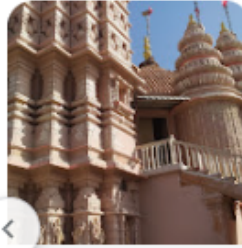

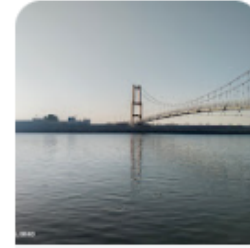

Day 05 Dwarka to Somnath

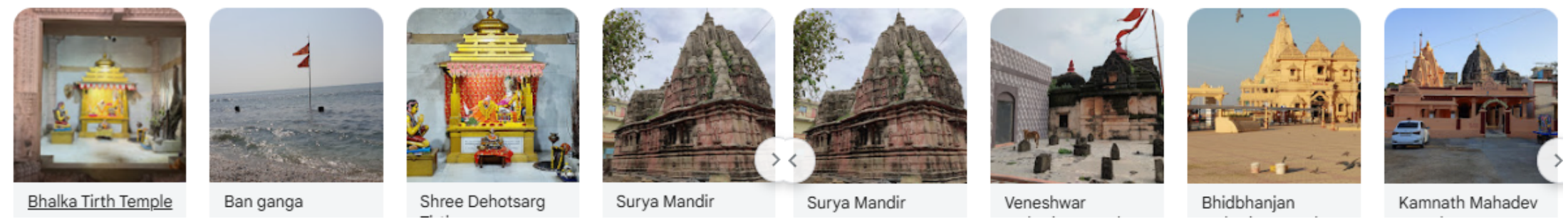

Gir National Park is the only place in the world outside Africa where a lion can be seen in its natural habitat. The lions of Gir are a majestic animal, averaging 2.75 meters in length, and with a bigger tail tassel, bushier elbow tufts and prominent belly folds than his African cousin which has larger mane. Gir is a home to 40 species of mammals and 425 species of birds.

Diu is a small island off the west coast of India, which is part of the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu. The island is also connected to the mainland by bridges. Diu is located in the Gulf of Khambhat (Cambay) of the Arabian Sea off the coast of Gujarat. It is a small island, with an area of ???about 38.8 square kilometers. The island is separated from the mainland by a narrow canal. Diu also includes two small mainland enclaves, Ghoghla and Simbor.

The Statue of Unity is the tallest statue in the world, standing 182 metres (597 ft) tall,[3] located near Kevadia in the Indian state of Gujarat. It depicts Indian politician and independence activist Sardar Patel (1875–1950), who was the first Deputy Prime Minister and Home Minister of independent India and a follower of Mahatma Gandhi. Patel played an important role in the political unification of India. The statue is located on the Narmada River in Kevadia Colony, opposite the Sardar Sarovar Dam, 100 kilometres (62 mi) southeast of the city of Vadodara.
